The Forest Rights and Governance Project located at the School of Habitat Studies, Mumbai invites applications for three research officers position for three months.

Positions: Three Research Officers, Location: Mumbai

Salary Amount: Between Rs. 25,000-30,000 per month (Negotiable)

Tenure: Three Months (December 2020-February 2021) and extendable for another nine months

**Job Description**

The selected candidates are required to carry out independent research and policy advocacy work on Forest Rights and Governance in India. Broadly, the position requires the research officers to- (1) analyse the policy and institutional challenges in the implementation of Forest Rights Act, (2) critically examine the livelihood and governance implications of community forest rights. The selected candidates are expected to do intensive field work and discussion with government officers as per the requirement of the project position.

**Eligibility Criteria**

Candidates having masters in social science and law with adequate knowledge in the field of forest rights and governance can send their application.
