The Centre for Trade and Investment Law (“CTIL”) was established in the year 2016 by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India. CTIL’s primary objective is to provide sound and rigorous analysis of legal issues pertaining to international trade and investment law. CTIL aims to be a thought leader in the various domains of international economic law such as the WTO law, investment law, and legal issues relating to economic integration.

CTIL, in partnership with the Directorate General of Trade Remedies (“DGTR”), is in the process of engaging Senior Research Fellows/Research Fellows, who will be deputed to the DGTR for performing specific legal research tasks. The appointment will be on a contractual basis initially for a period of One year which is extendible. Candidates who demonstrate superior capabilities will be provided higher responsibilities within the DGTR, including subsequent empanelment as a consultant which will attract higher pay and an expansion in responsibilities. Outstanding lawyers may even be assigned responsibility to represent the DGTR in court proceedings.

Candidates, applying for the Research Fellow position, should possess the following minimum qualification:

- Degree in Law (LL. B/B.A.LL.B./B.B.A.LL.B./B.Sc. LL. B). An advance degree in Law (LL.M) with a specialization in trade law will be desirable.
- The candidates should enclose a scanned copy of their degree, mark list and C.V. along with the application, failing which the application will be rejected.

In addition to the above, candidates applying for the Senior Research Fellow position, should have atleast 3 years of relevant post-qualification experience.

Number of Vacancies: Five (5)

Tenure: The appointment will be on a contract basis initially for one year, with a possibility of further extension, on the basis of an annual appraisal of their performance.

Emoluments: The selected candidates for the role of: (i) Senior Research Fellow will be paid fixed monthly emolument of Rs. 55,000/- per month; and (ii) Research Fellow will be paid fixed monthly emolument of Rs. 45,000/- per month. The candidates may eligible for any other deputation allowances as may be determined.

The selected candidate will need to join immediately.
